#C4 – The screen to search for bills has 2 sections. The first is all the way at the top...



This section allows you to look-up a bill if you already know the bill number. Make sure the correct year is selected, enter the bill number and click GO.

Note: There are two kinds of bills – house bills (HB) and senate bills (SB). Not only do they start with a different letter, their number system is different so it is easy to tell them apart.

Enter a House Bill number from 2018 like this...



#C5 – When you click GO, the web page for the particular bill will be displayed.

The TEXT OF BILL section includes links to the various versions of the bill that have existed. The top one is the most recent. These links will let you view the various versions of the bill as a web page (if you click on HTM) or as a PDF (if you click on the words).

The COMMITTEE ACTIONS section lists events that occurred while the bill was in committee.



Further down the page, the BILL HISTORY section lists all of the things that have happened during the life of the bill.

SECTION E – How To Read A Bill

Bills are generally written in sections. Each section may be a modification of an existing section of the Connecticut General Statutes OR may be new. Each bill, or sometimes each section of a bill, will include an implementation date – often 07/01, 10/01, 01/01, or "effective from passage".

When a bill includes modifications to an existing statute, the modifications will begin like this...

- 1 Section 1. Section 53a-3 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):

and the particular sections being modified will be indicated with <u>underline</u> for added text and [brackets] for removed text, like this...

- 118 (24) "Frame or lower receiver" means the part of a firearm that
- 119 provides the action or housing for the hammer, bolt or breechblock
- 120 and firing mechanism, and includes a frame or lower receiver blank,
- 121 <u>casting or machined body that requires further machining or molding</u>
- 122 to be used as part of a functional firearm, and which is designed and
- 123 intended to be used in the "assembly", as that term is defined in section
- 124 <u>29-36, as amended by this act, of a functional firearm</u>.

and like this...

149 [(a)] (d) No [person] individual shall remove, deface, alter or obliterate the name of any maker or model or any maker's number, 150 unique serial number or other mark of identification on any firearm. 151 [as defined in section 53a-3.] The possession of any firearm upon 152 which any identifying mark, number or name has been removed, 153 154 defaced, altered or obliterated shall be prima facie evidence that the [person] individual owning or in possession of such firearm has 155 156 removed, defaced, altered or obliterated the same.

When a section of a bill is new, it will be displayed with no underline and no brackets, and will look like this...

184 Sec. 3. (NEW) (Effective from passage) The Department of Emergency 185 Services and Public Protection shall develop and maintain a system to 186 distribute a unique serial number or other mark of identification to any 187 individual requesting such number or mark in accordance with section 188 29-36 of the general statutes, as amended by this act. The department 189 shall maintain identifying information of the individual requesting the 190 number or mark and of the firearm for which each such number or 191 mark is requested.
